

Graves Burying Ground

Lowndes County, Alabama

Located about 15 miles west of Montgomery and one-half mile from the Manack railroad station site on Old Selma Road. It lies just off County Road 37 on a limited access side road on GE/Sabic Innovative Plastics property. Visitors need to ask permission at the gate 2 guard shack to access the property. The cemetery was surveyed January 31, 2009 by Elaine Rogers and John Brown.
